



# Manufacturing and the Quality Within

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This class was created with production personnel in mind. It explains the role they have in ensuring quality within their own department. A brief introduction to GMPs relevant to the manufacturing area is provided followed by a discussion on how these practices apply to daily activities. In addition, manufacturing employees are challenged to look for opportunities to improve compliance and then work with their Quality counterparts to follow through with improvements.

**Course Prerequisites:** None

**Course Objectives:** At the conclusion of the class a participant should have a basic understanding of the following:

- cGMPs relevant to the manufacturing environment
- How the relevant cGMPs relate to their actual everyday activities
- Examples of how manufacturing employees can directly affect their regulatory compliance.
- How the decisions manufacturing employees make each day can affect the quality of the product they are producing
- Actual examples of changes employees can make right now to improve compliance
- Strategies for working with Quality counterparts to implement improvements
