Poka yoke means error proofing in Japanese. It was invented by Toyota engineer Shigeo Shingo to help prevent errors in manufacturing. Now the same concepts are used in any type of process from construction to coding. This class introduces participants to the concepts of poka yoke, its benefits, and the type of work environment that enables it to be successful.
